NAXICAP Partners' project chosen by the Paris Commercial Court for the takeover of the Loisirs & Création store chain

DMC is happy with the decision handed-down today by the Paris Commercial Court to accept NAXICAP Partners' project. This project, which is spearheaded by the Naxicap Partners investment fund (Natixis Group), which holds 65% of the chain's capital, and Jean-Marie Pomares (Album Group), was chosen as the most satisfactory solution for taking-over the Loisirs & Création chain. Naxicap Partners' project provides for the takeover of 13 of the 21 stores and for keeping on 122 of the 171 staff currently employed by the chain.

As a reminder, the DMC Group and its three companies - DMC SA, SAIC VELCOREX and Loisirs & Création - were put into Court-ordered receivership (*redressement judiciaire*) on 5 May 2008.
